BECOMING A MEMBER

ANP Membership is open to suitably qualified notetakers and others who have an interest in notetaking.

There are three categories of membership. These are:

FULL - open to notetakers who hold notetaking qualifications recognised by ANP.

TRAINEE - open to notetakers currently working towards notetaking qualifications recognised by ANP.

ASSOCIATE - open to non-qualified notetakers and those with an interest in the profession.

RECOGNISED QUALIFICATIONS

Only existing fully qualified notetakers can register as a full member, dependent upon suitable qualifications. These are as follows:

- OCN Level 2 Certificate in Notetaking for Students with Disabilities in Higher Education
- OCN Level 3 Certificate in Notetaking for Students with Disabilities in Higher Education
- OCN Level 3 Certificate in Electronic Notetaking
- CACDP Level 2 Certificate in Manual Notetaking for Deaf People
- CACDP Level 2 Certificate in Electronic Notetaking for Deaf People
- CACDP Level 3 Certificate for Manual/Electronic Notetakers
- LOCN Level 3 Certificate in Notetaking for Disabled Students in HE

2 Trainee membership - £15 per year

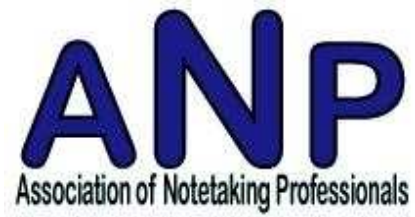
Maximum 2 year membership is permitted for trainees.
