ACCREDITED PRIOR LEARNING

For all applications to become a SASLI member through the APL route, SASLI will request full course transcripts. SASLI welcomes applications from interpreters who hold qualifications from outside the UK and will deal with these applications on an individual basis.

Registered Members

To become a Registered Member of SASLI, the applicant must hold one of the following qualifications:

1. UCLAN Post-graduate Diploma, BSL/English Interpreting and Translation
2. NVQ4 Interpreting
3. University of Leeds MA, or Post-graduate Diploma in Interpreting Studies BSL/English (with a mark of 53% or above for the module 'BSL for Interpreters MODL 5802').

Trainee Members

To become a Trainee Member of SASLI, through APL, the applicant must hold one of the following qualifications **and successfully complete the SASLI skills test**:

1. University of Bristol BSc (Hons), Deaf Studies including the Advanced BSL Interpreting module
2. Durham University Post-graduate Diploma, Interpreting with the Deaf Community
3. Heriot Watt University Graduate Diploma, BSL/English Interpreting Studies
4. Heriot Watt University Certificate, BSL/English Interpreting Studies
5. UCLAN BA (Hons), Deaf Studies
6. University of Wolverhampton BA (Hons), Interpreting BSL/English
